The fee needs to be arranged with the above. Please arrange for payment to be made before the wedding day.

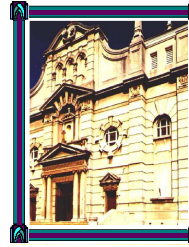
CHURCH OFFERING

There is no prescribed fee for the wedding but it is customary that an offering be made. As a guide it is suggested that this offering be approximately \$800. This money will cover:

- ◆ The use of the Church for the wedding and rehearsal.
- ◆ The hours of the priest: completion of all paperwork, the celebration of the ceremony, rehearsal and other appointments.
- ◆ Assistance in preparation of Marriage Liturgy.
- ◆ The marriage certificate issued by the Registrar.

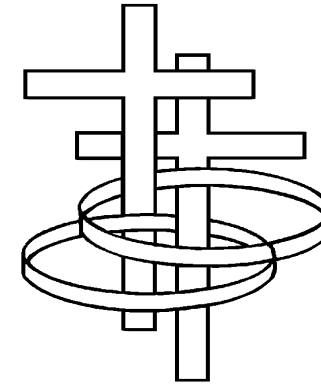
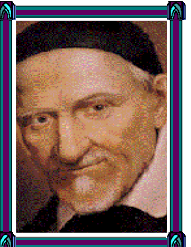
We suggest that this money be given to the Parish Secretary when booking is made.

Welcome

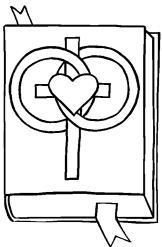
We extend a sincere welcome to you both as you make arrangement for your wedding in St. Vincent's Church, Ashfield.

The work of professionals or other individuals involved, such as the photographers, the video or sound operators should maintain the necessary high standard of liturgy, music and general behaviour in the Church.

Certificates required for marriage:

BIRTH CERTIFICATE

A full birth certificate (not an extract) is required by State law. If you do not have a birth certificate, please order one from the Registrar General, www.bdm.nsw.gov.au

If born overseas, a current passport may be presented.

CERTIFICATE OF BAPTISM

Catholics are asked to provide a recently issued Baptism Certificate i.e. issued within the past six months. An old certificate is **not** satisfactory. Please contact the Church where you were baptised. They will send you a copy of the certificate. We would be pleased to view the Baptismal Certificate of those of other Christian faiths.

Marriage Preparation Course

Couples are strongly encouraged to attend a Marriage Preparation Course. Please see the enclosed leaflets for the dates and venues of these programmes.



Flowers

Flowers (standard) are provided by the church and are arranged by the Parish Altar Society. Over and above the normal supply is an extra cost. If you wish to have additional flowers, you may contact **Mrs. June Hall on 9797 0112.** She will also coordinate the flowers to your colour scheme within reason.



The parties should arrive punctually for their ceremony at the time appointed. Late arrival will upset the timing of other ceremonies
